



Development of Numerology

It is neither proper nor practical to completely separate numbers and numerology. Hence when one is discussed, the other automatically creeps in. Number is touchstone of human civilization. It was invented thousands of years ago by our ancient sages. We have already seen that the concept of zero is totally Indian. Arabic numbers were made by the Indians which were adopted by the Arabians and through them they reached Europe. Its biggest proof is the Ashokan pillars on which his edicts were inscribed in Arabic numbers. At that time civilization was not even in cradle stage in Arabia. Scholars like Will Durant and Vincent Smith have accepted this. The game of chess was also started in India which is a miracle of numbers. Our ancestors have even told the exact number of years of each period (Yuga) very clearly. They have even informed us when the present period or Kalyuga had started, how much of it has been spent, how much time for this era remains and on which date and time Lord Kulki incarnation will take place has all been forecasted.

That explains why world famous astrologer and Numerologist Cheiro spent number of years in India and learnt this science from the Brahmins. He has written his book that Indian greats were masters of this knowledge since millennium and he has acquired this knowledge from them. Pythagoras's name is taken with respect in the field of science and knowledge and in his own words the world was formed by the power of numbers and Indians has known about it for quite sometime.



Indian masters have done lot of work on numbers and figures formed by them. Except 1 which can only be God, glimpse of other numbers is given here under.

Number	Description
1	God
2	Organic Gems
3	Deity, debts, serious, eyes
4	Yuga, Veda, Sub-Veda, Conscience, salvation, holy fire, priest.
5	Girls, elements, five items of cow, sacred metals, Motherlike, natural friends, worth, worshiping, Pandava.
6	Seasons, philosophies, fairies, daily deeds, six types of juices, diet.
7	Immortal, 7 pure cities, rivers, ocean, 7 saints, 7 islands, Brahma's sons, 7 forests, 7 mountains.
8	8 types of Lakshmi, self-attributes.
9	Planets, gems, 9 territories in India, classical texts, 9 forms of goddess Durga, 9 kinds of wealth.



There are examples of numbers from 1 to 9. Higher numbers like 56 kinds of food items, 108 beads of string, 64 powers of Goddess etc. all have some mysteries behind the numbers. Thus we see how advanced our sages were of their time. However this is also a fact that how our ancestors had arrived at their conclusions, on what basis, what were the formulas, much of all this is not known partly because in those days the greatmen gave such informations only to those who were deserving. Secondly the tradition continued by word of mouth. The pupil clammed the knowledge imparted by the teacher and thus the current of knowledge flowed from one to the next generation. Thirdly with the onslaught of time and foreign invaders destroyed thousands of volumes. For instance, Nalanda University and its library were consigned to flames by the invaders and the library was smouldering for 9 days. In spite of all this whatever literature remained intact is also remarkable.

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
